Business

1. Resolution #13 of 2020-JCAP Grant

A motion was made by Councilman VanArnam to adopt Resolution #13 of 2020- Justice Court Assistance Program grant as presented:

WHEREAS, the Town of Morristown desires to make continued improvements and enhancements to its Court, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Morristown wishes to make application to the Justice Court Assistance Program Grant for 2020,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board shall seek financial assistance from the Justice Court Assistance Program, grant for reimbursement of costs due to the corona virus for re-opening of the Morristown Justice Court; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Board shall authorize the Supervisor to make all necessary applications to the Justice Court Assistance Program.

2. 2021 Budget Review- Supervisor Putman had Carol Woodcock, Bookkeeper, run through the 2 funds available.

- General A Funds were reviewed line by line to explain each line amount.
- Historian 7510.1 was set at \$1,400 annual.
- It was noted that under revenue in General A the annual NYS consolidation money needs to be added.
- A7550.4 There was a question as to how much money was allocated for fireworks. The Board also decided to allocate \$1,400 for both fire departments for holiday children's parties.
- Some questions were raised regarding health insurance rates.
- Highway Funds were reviewed line by line.
- It was noted that the highway garage was in need of a generator for emergencies. The Board discussed available funds to purchase it.
- Sewer and water funds were not available at the time of the meeting. It was noted that wastewater district #1 needs a new vacuum pump right away. Quotes are being requested.
