

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT ON THE 14th DAY OF AUGUST, 2019, AT THE TOWN OF MORRISTOWN TOWN HALL, LOCATED AT 604 MAIN STREET, MORRISTOWN, COUNTY OF ST. LAWRENCE, STATE OF NEW YORK, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF MORRISTOWN WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING, WHICH SHALL COMMENCE AT 7:00 P.M. TO CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION: THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF MORRISTOWN RESOLVES TO DISSOLVE THE TOWN OF MORRISTOWN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 1 AS REQUIRED FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MORRISTOWN FIRE DISTRICT. THE DISSOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE AND OPERATIONAL ACTIVITIES OF THE MORRISTOWN FIRE DISTRICT.

DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY OF DISSOLUTION PLAN

THE TOWN BOARD PROPOSES TO DISSOLVE THE TOWN OF MORRISTOWN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 1 AS PART OF THE PROCESS TO CREATE A JOINT FIRE DISTRICT WHICH WILL PROTECT THE VILLAGE OF MORRISTOWN AND THE TERRITORY WITHIN THE TOWN OF MORRISTOWN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 1, BUT NOT INCLUDING ANY TERRITORY WITHIN THE BRIER HILL FIRE DISTRICT. THE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT HAS NO ASSETS, LIABILITIES OR EMPLOYEES AND THE MAXIMUM COST RELATED TO DISSOLUTION IS ESTIMATED AT \$500. THE DISSOLUTION IS CONTINGENT ON THE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MORRISTOWN FIRE DISTRICT. THE RESIDENTS OF THE TOWN OF MORRISTOWN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 1 WILL CONTINUE TO BE PROVIDED FIRE PROTECTION BY THE MORRISTOWN FIRE DEPARTMENT, AS PART OF THE MORRISTOWN FIRE DISTRICT, JUST AS THEY ARE NOW. THE TOWN OF MORRISTOWN WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED PLAN OF DISSOLUTION ON THE 14th DAY OF AUGUST, 2019, AT THE MORRISTOWN TOWN HALL, LOCATED AT, 604 MAIN STREET, MORRISTOWN, NEW YORK, WHICH SHALL COMMENCE AT 7:00 P.M. TO TAKE COMMENT FROM ANY INTERESTED PERSONS. THE PROPOSED DISSOLUTION WILL BECOME EFFECTIVE AT THE SAME TIME THAT THE MORRISTOWN FIRE DISTRICT BECOMES EFFECTIVE.
